- Acceptance letter/proof of enrollment into a historically black college and university
 - o Only the schools listed above will be accepted
- Submit a copy of your official high school transcript
 - o 2.5 GPA or above
- Submit the completed application
- Submit essay response (1000 words or less)

Please submit your application and essay by **April 7, 2023**. Submissions received after this date will not be considered.
